## NOTICES

### **SHEEP IDENTIFICATION AND TRACEABILITY REQUIREMENTS DOUBLE TAGGING REQUIREMENTS FROM 18<sup>th</sup> JANUARY 2008**

The new regulations require animals born after the 18<sup>th</sup> January 2008, and animals not previously identified to be double tagged with the exception of animals intended for slaughter (Slaughter Derogation)

**Slaughter Derogation** All animals intended for domestic slaughter with 12 months of age may be identified using a single "UK" ear tag.

**Tagging Requirements** For both the single and double tagging requirements the tags must be applied when they first move from the holding of birth and must have the following information.

**UK + Flock Mark of Birth + Unique individual Number of 6 digits.** (A "UK" tag).

**Animals intended for breeding** must be identified with two means of identification (two tags) even if moved off the holding of birth before the age of 12 months.

**Movements Tags** (S tags) S Baseline tags and F import tags are no longer required.

**Movement Documents** It is a legal requirement that all sheep must be accompanied with a **properly completed and signed Scottish Executive Movement Document** when moving to the market to allow accurate notification of movements to SAMU.

### **SHEEP SCAB ORDER 1997**

Consignors should note that it is a criminal offence if the owners of sheep

- Fail to treat sheep visibly affected with sheep scab
- Move sheep visibly affected with sheep scab

### **13 DAY STANDSTILL : MARKETS**

- Livestock moving off a market or returning home unsold will always trigger a 13 day standstill on that holding, (20 days for pigs), unless for slaughter or if another specific exemption applies.
- The use of approved Separation Facilities (agreed in advance with SEERAD) **may** allow movement to and from sales without affecting other stock on the holding.
- It is the consignor's responsibility to ensure that movements comply with current legislation.

### **WELFARE OF ANIMALS DURING TRANSPORT**

It is an offence to transport pregnant female animals to market for sale if they have reached the latest stage of gestation (within 10% of the estimated time of the gestation before birth) and for a period of one week after giving birth.

### **CONDITIONS OF SALE**

Conditions of Sale are displayed in the Sale Rings. Copies may be at the Office. No warranty is given or implied that Female Sheep are either free of lamb or have not had a lamb or lambs except where specifically stated otherwise.

## SCOTTISH BLUETONGUE VACCINATION CAMPAIGN

From the 30<sup>th</sup> April 2009 it is a legal requirement for all animals over 3 months of age to be fully vaccinated before moving off the holding of birth.

### **Vendor BTV Declaration**

As from 30<sup>th</sup> April 2009 all livestock for sale are therefore sold as fully BTV8 Vaccinated unless declared by the vendor as being under 3 months of age or exempt.

Animals which are moved into the compulsory areas of Scotland from an area not subject to compulsory BTV8 vaccination (such as England & Wales), must be vaccinated as soon as possible and not later than 14 days after entering the compulsory areas, unless the new keeper has documentary evidence that the animals were vaccinated before arrival.

### **Ongoing Requirements**

In order to maintain immunity one animal booster is required for all species. It is recommended that all livestock are given a booster during the vector free period each year.

**Where animals are found unvaccinated after 30 April 2009 producers can face a penalty of a fine up to £5,000 and / or 6 months imprisonment.**

### VETERINARY MEDICAL WITHDRAWALS

Unless otherwise stated at the time of sale (either by the auctioneer, on the catalogue or on the display screens) all livestock are sold as having completed all withdrawal periods for any veterinary medicines they have received. For any animals under treatment the details should be completed in the movement declaration form. It is the responsibility of the buyer to ensure that any animal destined for the food chain are outwith any withdrawal periods.

### New Livestock keepers:

#### Requirement to register with your Animal Health Office.

New keepers of the main livestock species (cattle, sheep, goats, pigs) are required to register their herds and flocks, and the "holdings" they are kept on, under EU Directives. This applies to any number of animals, including individual "pets".

### ORPHAN LAMBS

**Please Note :** All orphan lambs must have a **healed navel**, be **correctly ear tagged**, and must be removed from the market within **four hours** of arrival.

### **QMS - Farm Assurance**

Animals sold as Farm Assured are warranted by the vendor as being offered for sale from a Farm Assured Holding and this is denoted on the catalogue by the Farm Assurance Number.
